

SmarTone launches Caring Internet Support Scheme to support underprivileged families in continuing their studies during the pandemic

(Hong Kong, 28th April 2022) SmarTone fully supports students from underprivileged families in continuing their studies seamlessly online amidst school closures during the pandemic, collaborating with the Joint School Information Technology Society (JSIT) earlier to launch the "eLearning Support Scheme" powered by SmarTone Home 5G Broadband, in an effort to solve the internet access problem for underprivileged local families. Local primary and secondary school students who have been granted the "Subsidy Scheme for Internet Access Charges" (SIA) may now enjoy unlimited 5G data with free 5G Wi-Fi 6 router rental for a year at only HK\$1,600, the amount of which will be fully subsidised under the government funding scheme. The scheme aims to address students' immediate needs for online learning, and to help those in need continue their studies year-round, even amidst school closures during the pandemic.

Any local primary and secondary school students who have been granted the SIA can register for the "Online Learning Support Scheme" in a few simple steps with valid documentation. At only HK\$1,600 per year, eligible students can enjoy unlimited 5G data for one year, with free 5G Wi-Fi 6 router rental valued at HK\$780.
